## Women #3 at Long Course National Championships

Twenty-three members of the Virginia Masters Swim Team converged from various parts of our state as well as distant states to make a very strong showing at the recent long course national championship held in Buffalo, New York. This meet was held at the Erie Community College natatorium, a new facility that was erected for the 1993 World University Games. Our twelve women were placed in the "Large Team" division, while the eleven men were in the "Small Team" division with the combined total of twenty-three qualifying for the "Large Team" division overall.

The women had stiff competition from New England Masters, while the host club, Niagara, and D.C. Masters pulled away with first and second place, respectively. The women's team battled back and forth with New England Masters finally capturing third place by a slim 19.5 points by the meet's end. The final score for the women was 483.5 over New England's 464.

The men's team hovered between fifth and sixth place through most of the meet with the total team score ranking fifth in the "Large Team" division.

There were a large number of outstanding performances by the entire team, which ranged in age from Michael Weber at 24 to Marie Kelleher at 81. First place All Americans included Lisa Bennett (38) in the 50, 100, and 200 breaststroke and Marie Kelleher (81) in the 50 and 100 butterfly. The women's 200+ medley relay team placed first, seven seconds faster that their closest opponent (ironically, New England Masters) with Judy Decker. backstroke; Betsy Durrant, breaststroke; Lisa Bennett, butterfly; and Johnnie Detrick, freestyle.

We were proud of the performance by Virginia Masters Swim Team at nationals this year. The team included: Lisa Bennett, Susan Bleistein, Diane Cayce, Brooks Chance, Judy Decker, Johnnie Detrick, Betsy Durrant, Ann Jones, Marie Kelleher, Nancy Miller, Linda McCowan, Karen Tallmadge, Michael Cook, Mike Duignan, Bill Irwin, Bill Martin, Jim Miller, Ed McCowan, Pat Ryan, Michael Slowey, Forrest Sullivan, Michael Webber, and Chuck Wilmore. Thanks those individuals who, in the process of watching the team points, stayed to swim the dreaded sixth event.

## Fall Meet Scheduled for November 5

The 14th annual Virginia Masters Fall Swim Meet will be held in Norfolk on Saturday, November 5.

The event will take place in Norfolk Academy's Vaughn Aquatic Center. Swimmers may enter a total of 5 events. The fee for

#### \* 1994 POSTAL PENTATHLON SWIM MEET \*

Approval: By Minnesota LMSC for USMS Inc. # 304-13.

Eligibility: Open to all registered masters swimmers for the 1994 or 1995 season.

Conduct of Meet: Participant swims the 5 events, preferably in a 25 yard pool, Butterfly, Backstroke, Breast-stroke, Crawlstroke, and Individual Medley. All results will be based on a 25 yard course, swims performed in meter pools must indicate that their entries are from a meter pool so their times are converted to a yard equivalent. The meet results will compare each event of the pentathlon amongst the participants. It is recommended that the pentathlon legs be swum in the order Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Crawlstroke, and then Individual Medley. The events must be swum during the same day and it is recommended that all 5 events be swum in a 2 to 3 hour period. Participants may swim the Sprint, Middle Distance, Ironman, or any combination of courses. If you desire to swim more than one course you should swim each course on a separate day. All times must be recorded to the 1/100th of a second. Times not reporting tenths or hundredths will have 9's inserted for the missing digits. The pentathlon must be swum from September 15, 1994 to December 15, 1994 and the entries must be postmarked by December 24, 1994, include a copy of your USMS registration card or foreign equivalent. Incomplete entries will be returned and assessed a \$2.00 (US funds) administration fee. All fees are non-refundable.

Age Groups: 19-24, 25-29, ..., 90-94, 95+. Age will be determined by the swimmers age on December 15, 1994.

Awards: Winners of each age group will receive a special award. All participants may purchase a participation T-shirt for \$12.00 (US funds), XXL shirts add \$3.00(US).

Entry Fee: \$5.00(US) per course. Make checks payable in US funds to: Postal Pentathlon Swim Meet. All fees are non-refundable.

# POSTAL PENTATHLON OFFERS THREE COURSES

Wayde E. Mulhern of the Minnesota Masters Swim Club recently announced that the 1994 Postal Pentathlon Swim Meet offers three different options: a Sprint course; a Middle Distance; and an Ironman course. The meet of five events, butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke, freestyle, and individual medley, gives you the opportunity to compete internationally without the expense and inconvenience of traveling to a meet. After you swim the five events, preferably in a 25 yard pool, you simply mail in the results on the official entry form for tabulation. All entries must be postmarked by December 24, 1994.

Participants may swim the Sprint, Middle Distance, Ironman or any combination of the courses. The Sprint distance challenges you to swim four fifties plus a 100 IM. The Middle Distance course is a total of 600 yards/meters broken down to four hundreds plus a 200 IM. The Ironman course challenges you to swim four two-hundreds and a 400 IM for a total distance of 1200. The meet results will compare each event of the pentathlon amongst the participants. All results will be based on a 25 yard course; swims performed in meter pools must indicate that their entries are from a meter pool so their times can be converted to a yard equivalent. Times must be recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second.

The events must be swum on the same day and it is recommended that all 5 events be swum in a 2 to 3 hour period. If you desire to swim more than one course you should swim each course on a different day. Winners of each age group will receive a special award. All participants may purchase a T-Shirt.

This is the sixth annual postal pentathlon meet conducted by Minnesota Masters. It attracts entries from all across America and international entries from Australia, Canada, and England. An entry form is enclosed with this newsletter.
