LMSC Chair Patty Miller sent the following correspondence.

Many LMSC's offer information on their website about USMS Masters certification and we want to make sure you are offering the most current information available to your members.

In January of 2014, USMS brought the USMS Masters Certification process in-house and as a result, ASCA no longer processes the applications or issues the certificates for USMS coach certification. Following is updated information on the USMS Masters certification requirements.

The USMS Coaches Committee and Club and Coach Services have developed and currently offer, three levels of Masters coach certification. The courses are taught in classroom settings throughout the country by USMS-certified instructors. At the conclusion of the courses, USMS issues certification to successful candidates.

If you're already an American Swimming Coaches Association-certified coach and have completed the ASCA Masters track prior to December 1, 2010, you'll continue to have your Masters certification recognized by USMS, regardless of your current ASCA membership status, as long as you maintain your USMS membership. However, you're invited to take these adult-specific courses, for which you'll earn credits toward ASCA's continuing education requirements.

To Become a USMS Certified Masters Coach, you must:

- Be a member of USMS
- Attend the Masters coach certification course
- Successfully complete the end-of-course tests

USMS values ASCA's service as an advocate for the swim coach profession and the sport of swimming and encourages all swim coaches to consider ASCA membership.

ASCA recognizes the USMS Masters coach certification course and will issue ASCA Masters coach certification to their members who:

- Attend the USMS Masters coach certification course
- Submit the required documents to ASCA:
 - ASCA Certified Masters Coach application
 - Completed tests from any USMS coach certification courses.
- Join ASCA Membership fee is \$70 for one year. More information about ASCA may be found here: www.swimmingcoach.org

Certification Process:

 Upon successful completion of the classroom coursework, including all required applications and successfully completed tests, each person will be awarded USMS Level 1 or 2 Certified Masters Coach certification. Coaches desiring optional ASCA Masters coach certification must complete the classroom coursework and submit all required membership, applications and completed tests directly to ASCA.

swims from the LCM Commonwealth Games are not recognized by FINA, neither are swims at USA-S meets (we lost a few swims this way). FINA also does not recognize swimmers who are younger than 25 years old; that means the 18-24 age group doesn't count, and even relays that are old enough to fit into an age group are ineligible if they have one swimmer who is younger than 25 (we lost one relay this way).

Also, sometimes people confuse the FINA and USMS Top 10 lists. The FINA lists are for world rankings, the USMS is US only.

Editor's Notes:

- 1. Chris also pointed out to me that the lists I published last month were **draft** lists. There could be a few corrections for the final list. Check at usms.org. Select "Events and Results" and then "Top Ten."
- 2. This list is for SC and LC Meter meets. FINA does not recognize yard meets. Most of these times were achieved at the Zone LC meet in Richmond (LC) and Virginia Beach Meet (SC).
- 3. Most of the relays listed for our LMSC are for the longer relays (400 and 800).

All USMS swimmers **must** include a copy of your registration card with your entry or submit it at the meet for times to be submitted for USMS Records and Top Ten consideration.

ORDER OF EVENTS: Warm-ups: 8:30 am to 9:30 am. Meet starts at 10:00 am. Swimmers will be able to enter the facility by 8:00 am.

ENTRIES: \$13.00 per event; \$10.00 surcharge to help defray cost of equipment rentals, mailing, medals, etc. Relays will cost \$15.00 per each relay entered. Relays will be deck entered and deck seeded. Swimmers may enter up to five (5) individual events plus relays. If entering 5 events please mail in registration & payment in order to receive a \$15 discount (after mail in fee)! With the discount 5 events is \$45 – discount NOT available through online registration. **There will be an additional \$5.00 fee for all mail-in registrations**.

ENTRY DEADLINES: ENTRIES ARE DUE BY JUNE 13, 2014. Be sure to sign the liability waiver. If you are a registered USMS swimmer, you must provide a copy of your 2013 USMS card. Paper entries should be mailed to the address at the bottom of this page. **Online entries are available at www.Commonwealthgames.org.**

RULES: Current USMS rules on Masters swimming will apply. No one will swim alone in a heat. Swimmers will be seeded according to times; heats will run slowest to fastest. Men and women will swim together. Swimmers will be expected to cooperate with the safety marshal who will monitor warm-ups. No diving during warm-ups except in designated lanes.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded for 1st through 3rd places in each event in each age group and also for relays.
