#### SUBWAY COMMONWEALTH GAMES OF VIRGINIA LONG COURSE STATE SWIM MEET FOR 18 AND UP

Recognized by LMSC for VIRGINIA for USMS, INC., Recognition No. 124-R001

**DATE:** Saturday, June 21, 2014

**LOCATION:** Christiansburg Aquatic Center, 595 North Franklin Street, Christiansburg, VA

**FACILITY:** 8 Lane, 50 Meter Pool, non-turbulent lane markers. Six lanes will be used for competition; two lanes will be available for continuous warm-ups and cool-downs. **Pool has been measured and certified for USMS records and Top Ten.** 

**SPONSORED BY:** Virginia Amateur Sports, Inc. and Virginia Masters Swim Team

**MEET REFEREE:** Susan Munson

**ELIGIBILITY:** This is a USMS recognized meet for purposes of USMS Records and Top Ten times by USMS swimmers. Standard USMS age groups will be used (18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, etc). For meets held in 50 meter pools, your age as of December 31, 2014 is considered your swimming age for the meet. All USMS swimmers **must** include a copy of your registration card with your entry or submit it at the meet for times to be submitted for USMS Records and Top Ten consideration.

**ORDER OF EVENTS**: Warm-ups: 8:30 am to 9:30 am. Meet starts at 10:00 am. Swimmers will be able to enter the facility by 8:00 am.

<sup>\*</sup>Relays: There will be one heat of each relay; Women, Men and Mixed relays will be swum in the same heat. All relays will be deck entered.

**ENTRIES:** \$13.00 per event; \$10.00 surcharge to help defray cost of equipment rentals, mailing, medals, etc. Relays will cost \$15.00 per each relay entered. Relays will be deck entered and deck seeded. Swimmers may enter up to five (5) individual events plus relays. If entering 5 events please mail in registration & payment in order to receive a \$15 discount (after mail in fee)! With the discount 5 events is \$45 – discount NOT available through online registration. **There will be an additional \$5.00 fee for all mail-in registrations**.

**ENTRY DEADLINES: ENTRIES ARE DUE BY JUNE 13, 2014.** Be sure to sign the liability waiver. If you are a registered USMS swimmer, you must provide a copy of your 2013 USMS card. Paper entries should be mailed to the address at the bottom of this page. **Online entries are available at www.Commonwealthgames.org.** 

**RULES:** Current USMS rules on Masters swimming will apply. No one will swim alone in a heat. Swimmers will be seeded according to times; heats will run slowest to fastest. Men and women will swim together. Swimmers will be expected to cooperate with the safety marshal who will monitor warm-ups. No diving during warm-ups except in designated lanes.

**AWARDS:** Medals will be awarded for 1st through 3rd places in each event in each age group and also for relays.

**Event:** There will be two races: a 2-mile cable swim at 8:30 am and a 1-mile cable swim beginning at 10:30 am. The 2-mile swim will consist of 4 laps in a counter-clockwise direction around a ¼-mile straightaway cable, with start and finish in the water. The 1-mile race will consist of 2 laps around the ¼-mile cable in a clockwise direction. Both the 1-and 2-mile distances are certified and qualify for national records. No splits or premature finishes will be eligible for records. The lake opens at 7am and warm-up on the cable course will be available from 7:15-8:15am.

• Anticipated water temp: 78° to 82°

NO WETSUITS ALLOWED

#### **Check-in Closes at:**

2-Mile: 8:15 AM 1-Mile: 10:15 AM

Eligibility: Open to all swimmers 18 years & older as of July 12, 2014. Paper entries must include a copy of your 2014 USMS card. Online entries will be verified automatically. "One Event" is available through online registration for an additional fee of \$25.30. To renew or join USMS online, visit www.usms.org/reg

**Rules:** Current 2014 USMS rules will govern both races.

<u>Entries:</u> All snail mail entries must be postmarked by July 3, 2014. Online entries will close at 11:59pm Eastern Time on July 7, 2014. Late or race-day entries will NOT be accepted. You may enter both events. Online entry is strongly encouraged. Entry fee is \$32/\$42.

<u>Safety:</u> For safety reasons, swimmers who cannot complete 1 mile in 1 hour or 2 miles in 2 hours should NOT enter. Swimmers still on the course after the time limit will be stopped and listed as DNF in the results. In the event of inclement weather, the race director may close the course and thereby prevent swimmers from completing the race. The Charlottesville-Albemarle rescue/dive team will be on site with boats, scuba divers, and a rescue squad.

**Seeding:** Swimmers will be seeded fastest to slowest according to 1650 seed time and will be started in waves of 10 swimmers, staggered at 30-second intervals. "No Time" entries will be seeded in the final wave. Seeding changes will not be allowed on race day.

**Age Groups:** 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, etc. in five year increments, as high as necessary for both men/women.

**Awards/ Social:** For both races, custom awards will be given to the top 3 men & women finishers in each age group. The awards ceremony will take place on the beach following the 1-mile race. Drinks and snacks will be provided.

Take Rt. 29 toward Charlottesville, VA. In Earlysville, turn right onto Airport Rd. (Rt. 649). Travel 7/10 mile toward airport. At roundabout, bear right onto 606. Go 1.2 miles and turn left onto Chris Greene Lake Rd. Proceed past guardhouse and follow the road downhill and around the lake to the parking lot at the end of the road.

#### from Richmond, VA:

(Distance: 75 miles, Drive Time: ~ 90 minutes)

Take I-64 West to exit 124, Charlottesville/Shadwell, (U.S. 250 West), to U.S. 29 North. Follow U.S. 29 North approximately 6 miles to Airport Rd. (Rt. 649). Turn left onto Airport Rd., go 7/10 mile toward airport and follow the underlined directions above.

#### from Waynesboro, VA:

(Distance: 34 miles, Drive Time: ~ 45 minutes)

Take I-64 East to exit 118B, Charlottesville/Culpeper, (U.S. 29 North Bypass), to U.S. 29 North. Follow U.S. 29 North approximately 6 miles to Airport Rd. (Rt. 649). Turn left onto Airport Rd., go 7/10 mile toward airport and follow the underlined directions above.
