Inaugural Club Tribe Masters Classic Meet Recap

On Saturday, March 19, 2016, Club Tribe Masters Swimming (1693) hosted the Inaugural Club Tribe Masters Classic, welcoming 76 swimmers from 15 clubs to the College of William & Mary in Williamsburg. The meet was a special homecoming for the many Club Tribe swimmers who are W&M Swimming alumni, replete with venerated pre-meet rituals and our beloved Towel Cheer before the final relay. Current W&M swimmers volunteered to run the meet, serving as timers, lap counters, dry deck clerks and jovial announcers. We were pleased to be joined by fellow competitors from across Virginia and beyond, and we were particularly glad to offer a Masters meet on the Peninsula, which enjoys strong and growing USMS participation. We plan to make this an annual event.

There were many impressive individual swims, including 11 new Virginia LMSC records: Miriam Tuovila of TMAS, W 90-94 50 BR (1:22.99) and 100 BR (3:24.13); Johnnie Detrick of VMST, W 80-84 50 BK (50.15), 100 BK (1:52.18) and 50 Fly (53.01); Gabby Mizerak of 1693, W 18-24 200 IM (2:14.60); Doug Slater of 1693, M 55-59 50 FR (24.18r), 100 FR (52.72), 50 BK (28.03) and 100 BK (1:00.16), and Greg Harris of VMST, M 50-54 200 IM (2:08.37).

The smaller scale of the meet gave Club Tribe the opportunity to split relays evenly for some spirited intra-squad racing. In the first heat of the 200 Free Relay, Club Tribe's Mixed team opened with a scorching 20.95 from Kevin Gallagher. Club Tribe's Women's team valiantly fought all the way back, only to be DQed for an early takeoff. Two Club Tribe Men's relays faced off in the next heat, with Slater, Mike Cook, John Rockwell and Scott

Hensley out-touching Dan Earle, Rich Williams, Jim Griffin and Michael Lovett by a fingernail (0.09), despite a 21.92 anchor leg by Lovett. SHYM joined Club Tribe for a single combined heat of the Women's, Men's and Mixed 200 Medley Relay, with notable splits from Club Tribe's Mizerak (Fly – 26.15) and Sidney Glass (BR – 26.96).

The meet concluded with its marquee event: the 100 Medley Relay, with each swimmer on the winning Men's, Women's and Mixed 100 Medley Relay receiving custom engraved pewter Jefferson cups commemorating victory. With the gorgeous hardware gleaming atop the relay table, a fantastic Women's team from QMST faced off against the Women of Club Tribe, who laid down quite a marker for teams to chase in future years: Stefanie Farhat, Courtney Hurtubise, Mizerak and Katie Grier touched in 54.43. In a three-way all-Club Tribe nail-biter, the Men's record was established at 50.97, as Rockwell, Glass, Griffin and Cook re-took the lead on the final stroke and won by 0.14. The meet concluded with some more mayhem in the Mixed version, with all three Club Tribe relays finishing within 0.21 of each other. The final batch of Jefferson cups went to Slater, Williams, Farhat and Grier in 53.04. We know there is a ton of talent (and speed!) in our LMSC, and we look forward to more teams joining the fray in the 100 Medley Relay next year.

We are tremendously grateful to Heather Stevenson, Chris Stevenson and Charlie Cockrell for helping us launch and run a brand new meet, and to Janet Law and her outstanding officiating crew for their work. We look forward to growing this meet into a Virginia LMSC mainstay.



SCM 2015 Season Wrap-Up

The final Top 10 lists for the 2015 short-course meters season (SCM15) have been published. The season ran from Jan 1, 2015 thru Dec 31, 2015. Swimmers from our LMSC did well: 115 ranked individual swims and 11 ranked relays. There were 37 swimmers who had at least one Top 10 swim; Shirley Loftus-Charlie led the way with 11 ranked swims, followed by impressive performances (8 swims each) by Gregory Harris and Johnnie Detrick. There were three swimmers who had at least one top-ranked swim in an individual event: Johnnie was #1 in **all** eight of her swims, while Miriam **Tuovila** (4) and **Sidney Glass** (2) were also tops in at least one event. There were also five relay swims that were ranked #1 in the country, three by **VMST** in the Women's 320+ age group and two by **Club Tribe** in the Mixed 120-159 age group. Congratulations to these fine swimmers and everyone else who was on the list! More details on these and other recent Top 10 achievements are given elsewhere on our website. Anyone making a Top 10 list can order Top 10 patches to commemorate the achievement. Nicely-formatted booklets are also available for download or order. The LMSC record book was also re-written in the past SCM season: 44 new individual records were set, led by Gregory with seven records, while Johnnie was close behind with six new marks. Johnnie also set eight new Colony Zone **records**, while **Miriam Tuovila** also set three new records at the zone level. There were also **9 new** relay records, set by VMST (5), Club Tribe (3) and **RSMS** (1), the new masters team at VCU. The mythical national championship rankings are based on scoring the Top 10 swims by zone, LMSC or club. As an LMSC, Virginia was ranked 12th out of the 52 LMSCs, while VMST achieved an impressive ranking of #22 out of more than 250 scoring clubs nation-wide! Congratulations to everyone on a great season!

Event: There will be two races: a 2-mile cable swim at 8:30 am and a 1-mile cable swim beginning at 10:30 am. The 2-mile swim will consist of 4 laps in a counter-clockwise direction around a ¼-mile straightaway cable, with start and finish in the water. The 1-mile race will consist of 2 laps around the ¼-mile cable in a clockwise direction. Both the 1-and 2-mile distances are certified and qualify for national records. No splits or premature finishes will be eligible for records. The lake opens at 7am and warm-up on the cable course will be available from 7:15-8:15am.

- Anticipated water temp: 78° to 83°

Eligibility: Open to all swimmers 18 years & older as of July 9, 2016. Paper entries must include a copy of your 2016 USMS card. Online entries will be verified automatically. "One Event" is available through online registration for an additional fee of \$31.30. To renew or join USMS online, visit www.usms.org/reg

Rules: Current 2016 USMS rules will govern both races.

Entries: All snail mail entries must be postmarked by July 1, 2016. Online entries will close at 4:59pm **Eastern Time on July 6, 2016.** Late or race-day entries will NOT be accepted. You may enter both events. Online entry is strongly encouraged. The entry fees are \$39 (1-mile race) and \$49 (2-mile race).

Safety: For safety reasons, swimmers who cannot complete 1 mile in 1 hour or 2 miles in 2 hours should NOT enter. Swimmers still on the course after the time limit will be stopped and listed as DNF in the results. In the event of inclement weather, the race director may close the course and thereby prevent swimmers from completing the race. The Charlottesville-Albemarle rescue/dive team will be on site with boats, scuba divers, and a rescue squad.

Seeding: Swimmers will be seeded fastest to slowest according to 1650 seed time and will be started in waves of 10 swimmers, staggered at 30-second intervals. "No Time" entries will be seeded in the final wave. Seeding changes will not be allowed on race day.

Age Groups: 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, etc. in five year increments, as high as necessary for both men/women. **Awards/ Social:** For both races, custom awards will be given to the top 3 men & women finishers in each age group. The awards ceremony will take place on the beach following the 1-mile race. Drinks and snacks will be provided.
