LCM 2016 Season Wrap-Up

The final Top 10 lists for the 2016 long-course meters season (LCM16) have been published. The season ran from Oct 1, 2015 thru Sept 30, 2016.

Swimmers from our LMSC did well: **59 ranked individual swims and 2 ranked relays.**There were 13 swimmers who had at least one Top 10 swim; **Kelly Parker Palace** led the way with 11 ranked swims, followed by impressive performances by **Beth Schreiner** (7 swims), **Barbara Boslego** and **Johnnie Detrick** (6 each). There were four swimmers who had at least one top-ranked swim in an individual event: Beth and Johnnie were #1 in six of their swims, while Kelly (5), and **Amalia Kobelja** (2) were also tops in at least one event. Congratulations to these fine swimmers and everyone else who was on the list!

The <u>LMSC record book</u> was also re-written in the past season: **44 new individual records** were set, led by Kelly with 13 records, while Beth and **David Malsbury** also impressed with

five new marks apiece. Kelly also set six new Colony Zone records, while Johnnie, Amalia and Beth also set at least one new zone record this season. There were also **2 new relay records**, both set by VMST.

The mythical national championship rankings are based on scoring the Top 10 swims by zone, LMSC or club. As an LMSC, Virginia was ranked 17th out of the 52 LMSCs. At the club level, VMST was ranked 26th out of more than


270 clubs that had swimmers in the Top 10. Wow!

David Gregg Meet Report

The David Gregg III Memorial meet was held Feb 4-5 in Richmond. There were 103 swimmers entered in the meet, and lots of fast swimming was in evidence! The <u>results have been uploaded</u> to the USMS database and posted on our website. <u>We have photos</u>, too!

There were **three national records** set during the meet: **Shirley Loftus-Charley** in the 65-69 Women's 200 butterfly, **Kelly Parker Palace** in the 55-59 Women's 1000 freestyle, and the VMST relay of Kathy Umbdenstock, Marcia Barry, Barbara Boslego, and Shirley Loftus-**Charley** set a new standard in the 65+ Women's 200 medley relay. Kelly's record was set as a split in the 1650, with all the age-group swimmers (there to help with the meet) lining up along the edge of the pool to cheer her home. There were 12 new **LMSC records** set, as well, 12 individual and 2 relay marks. Shirley led the way with six new records, while Rachel Nelson and Brent **Holsten** were also impressive with two new records apiece.

We had some new awards this year as well. The following swimmers took home gift baskets lovingly put together by Heather:

The Sprinter award went to the swimmers with the lowest cumulative time in the four 50 events. Greg Harris and Rachel
 Nelson showed their fast-twitch mastery of the short distances in claiming these awards.

- The **Middle Distance award** went to the swimmer with the lowest cumulative time in any four distinct 200s. **Shirley Loftus- Charley** won the women's award, while no man was tough enough to attempt it. (Shirley, by the way, entered *every single event* that was 200 yards or longer. Yikes!)
- The Distance award went to the swimmers with the lowest cumulative time in the 500, 1000 and 1650 freestyles; these went to George Sushkoff and Charlotte Hollings.



Those who missed the 12 swimmer cut-off may place themselves on a first-come, first-served wait list upon arriving at the meet. Those on the wait list who are able to swim will the \$8 entry fee. The final 1000 Free heat sheets will be posted by 3:15 pm. W&M varsity swimmers will serve as lap counters.

Psych Sheets, Heat Sheets and Results will be posted at www.vaswim.org and will be sent by email to meet registrants. Heat Sheets will be emailed by Friday, March 17, and will be posted at multiple locations on the pool deck. (Editor: It's probably a good idea to print your own heat sheet, if possible.)
