Swim Across America

Swim Across America (SAA) for the Richmond Community Pool Swim is a fundraiser for cancer research. As in past years, funds stay local and VCU Massey Cancer Center is the beneficiary of fundraising in Richmond. This year, the event is a pool swim on August 26, 2023, at the Quest Swimming pool, 6800 Deer Run Drive, Midlothian. There are several swimming options: 1/2-mile, 1-mile, or "as many laps as possible."

Several of us have directly benefitted from the research and cancer-fighting techniques developed at Massey Cancer Center. Here is a testamonial from our own George Sushkoff about SAA:

For those of not familiar with this organization, SAA funds cancer research grants and patient programs. Charity swims are held all across America, hence the name. All the money from the Richmond event goes to Massey Cancer Center. In 2022, SAA Richmond presented a check to Massey for \$100,000. Since 2019, over \$250,000 has been raised for Massey.

I have supported SAA since 2000. I formed a team in 2021 and 2022. Last year, my team, River City Masters raised over \$26,000. Little did I know that I would become a beneficiary less than one year later. I was diagnosed with Colon Cancer on April 14th, and shortly afterwards I began my treatment track with tests, scans, and surgeon consultations.

I was unaware of the patient advocacy that SAA does until my friend Erica Burgess mentioned it to me on April 17th. She offered to reach out to SAA, and I accepted. The CEO of SAA, Rob Butcher, called me at noon that day. He gave me things to think about including quality of life, tests, and a second opinion. He offered to get in touch with Massey. Again, I accepted. I then got an email from Rob around 6 PM. Massey wants to help, he told me.

I got a call from a nurse at Massey on April 18th. After an explanation on her part, and agreement from me, they kicked off the second opinion process. Massey would review the same imagery and cell samples and put this up to a tumor review board. At no time did they pressure me to switch care from Virginia Cancer Institute (VCI) to Massey. They did find something that the original imaging techs did not. As a result, the tumor was upgraded, and the treatment plan would be more aggressive – all in the hopes to avoid surgery. I was so impressed with the speed at which SAA and Massey reacted. Also, I did not have to do any work. Massey set all the appointments.

The Clinic Course is designed to provide guidance and practice running a clinic. Instructors at any level can take the course, but it's perhaps most appropriate for the less experienced.

The Adult Learn to Swim Certification (ALTS) is designed to teach adults how to teach other adults to swim. Adult learners are different than children. This course covers some of the particular needs of adult learners as well as the fundamentals of teaching swimming. This certification course is great for:

- Current swim instructors who want to enhance their credentials.
- Current triathlon coaches and personal trainers who want to enhance their credentials.
- Anyone interested in becoming a swim instructor working with adult learners.

The Stroke Development Clinic is not a learn to swim class - participants should already be able to swim freestyle and feel safe in the water. It is designed for adult swimmers who have some experience swimming and would like to work on improving their strokes. All four strokes will be covered during the four hours. The course is taught in a six lane, warm-water instructional pool that is no deeper than 5.5 feet.

The reimbursement form will be provided closer to the actual courses and during the weekend of instruction.


